Biophilia (2016) World Premiere

Biophilia is a composed generative sound and video installation created with the artists' field recordings of birds, trees and insects in an old-growth forest in Fillongley Park, Canada. The project proposes an ecological video-sound-scape, by combining human instrumentation with more-than-human sound-and-visual-making. Andreyev's theremin responses contribute to an acoustical pattern of relating between human, plant and animal players. Overstall's computational techniques combine the material with generative events informed by daily rhythms of the forest, and by the experience of being there. For the audience, *Biophilia* creates new opportunities for sensing our ecological relations.
